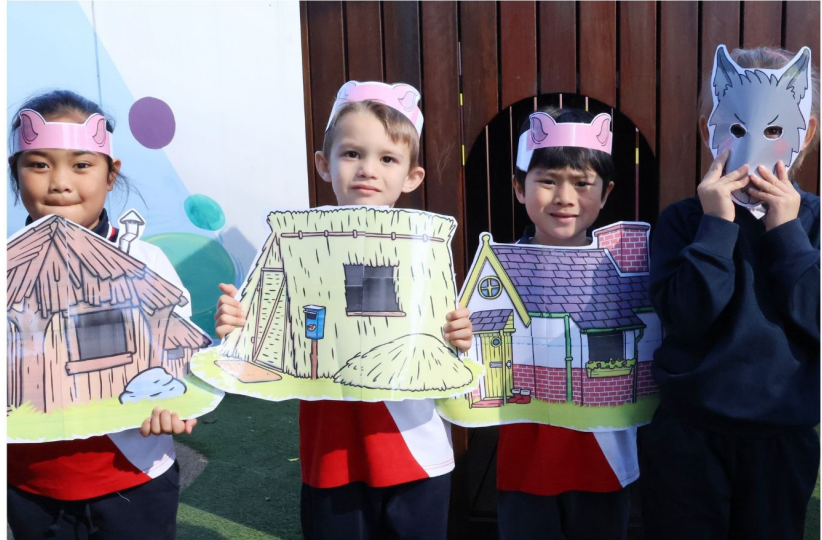




DRAMATIC STORYTELLING
