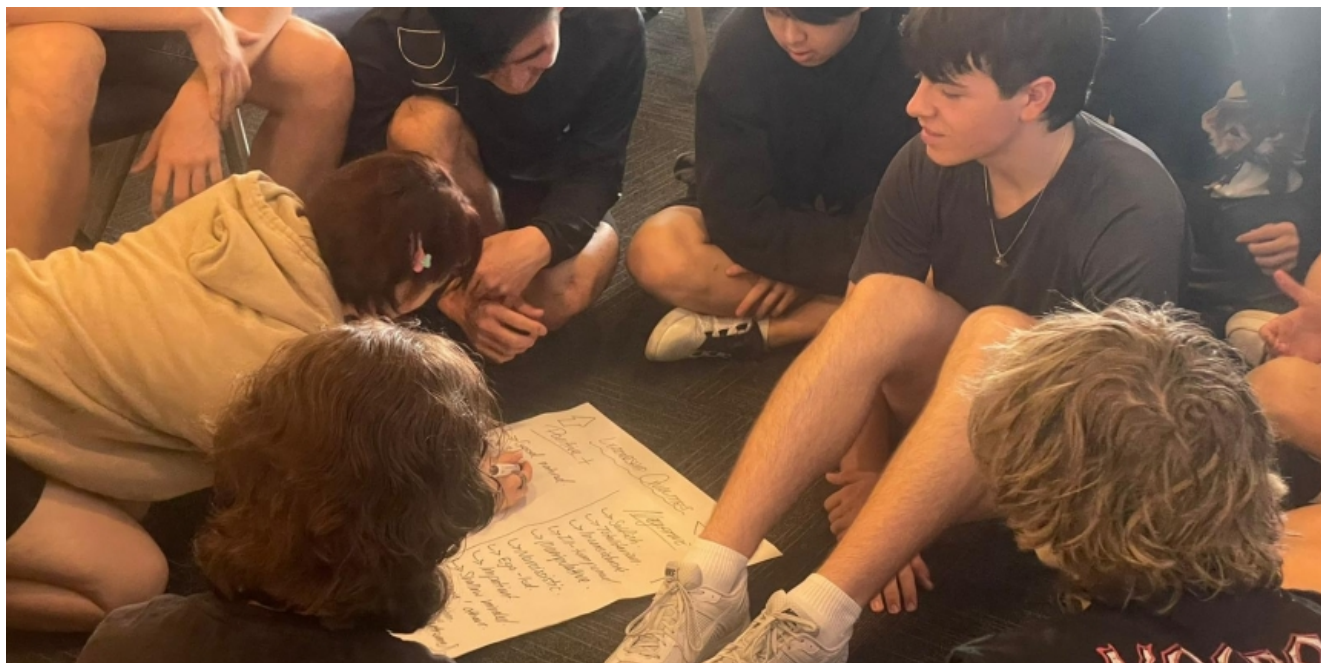




YEAR 11 CAMP YOUTHWORKS RATHANE
