Welcome back to Term 3 and to what will be another fantastic term of sport!

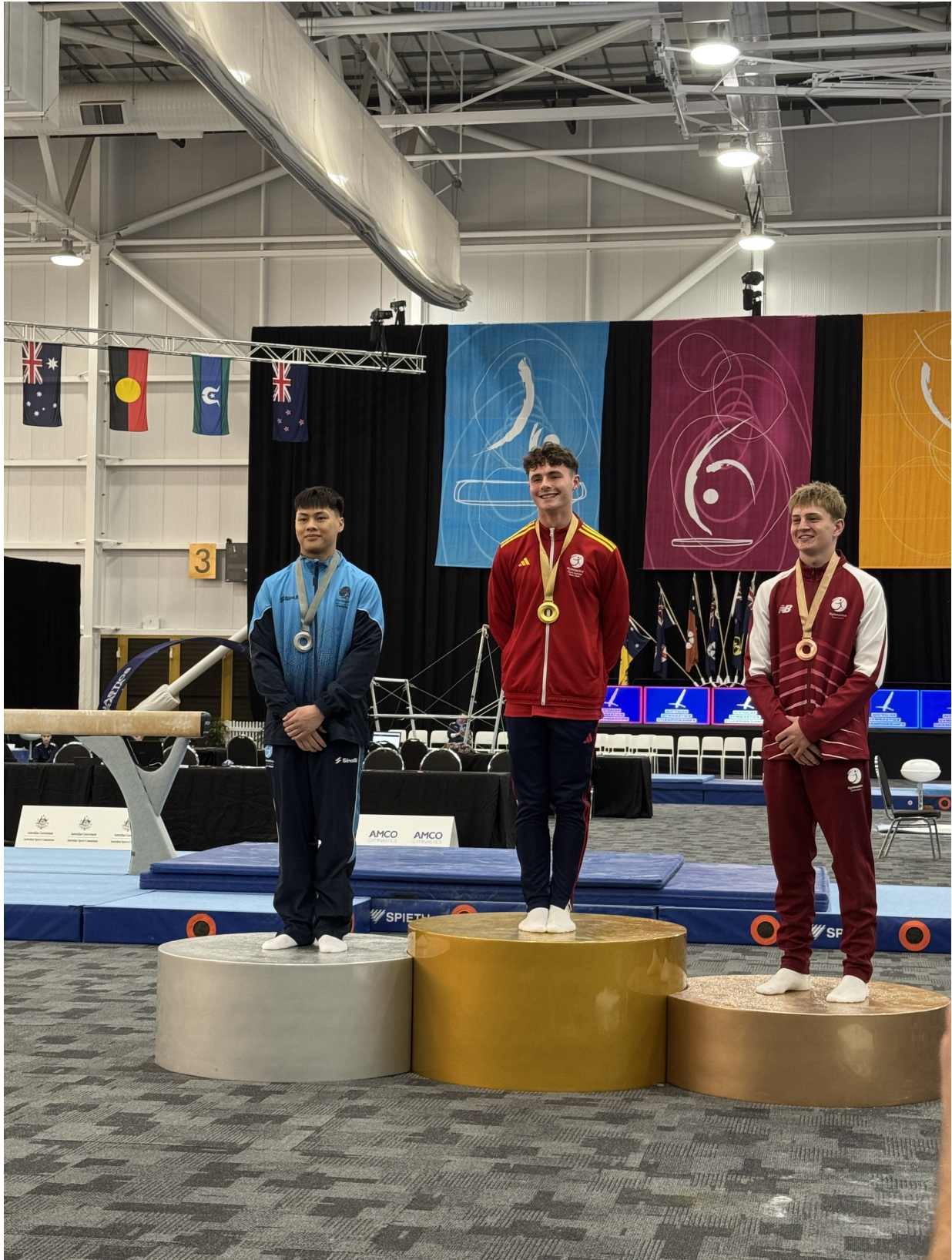
