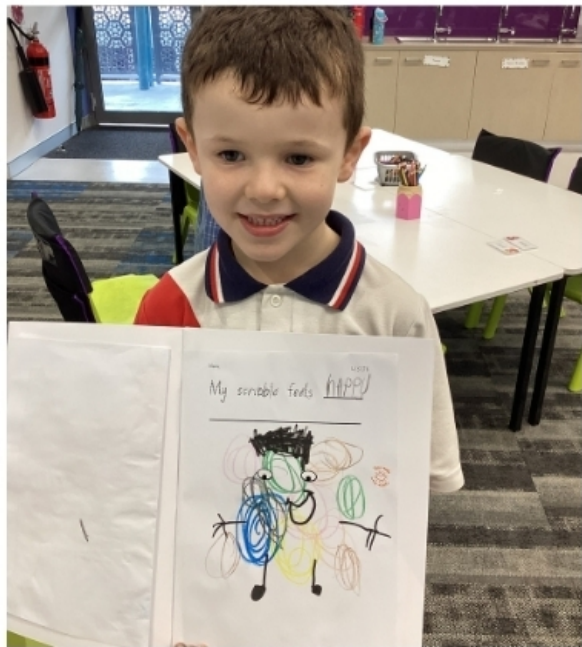
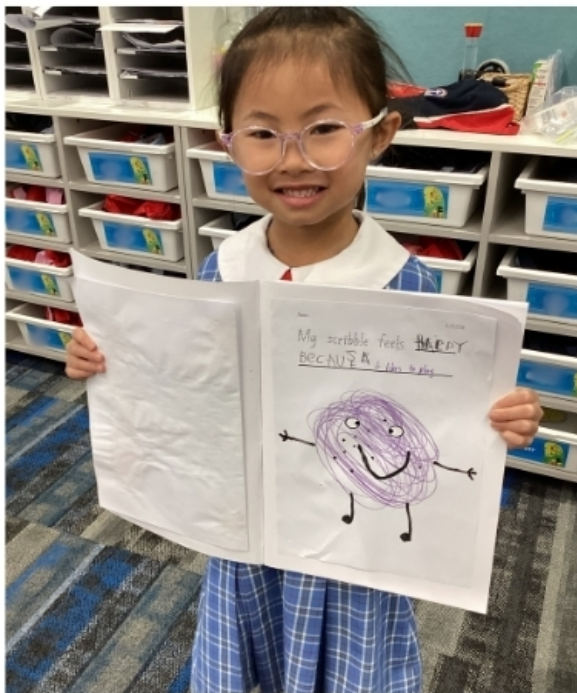
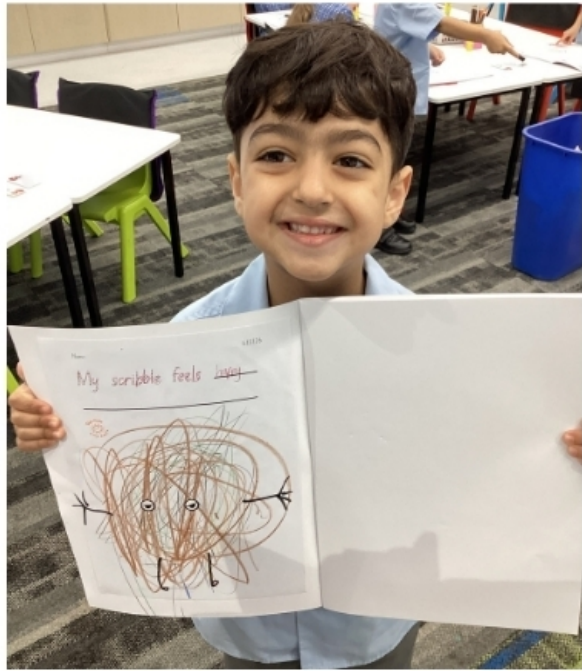
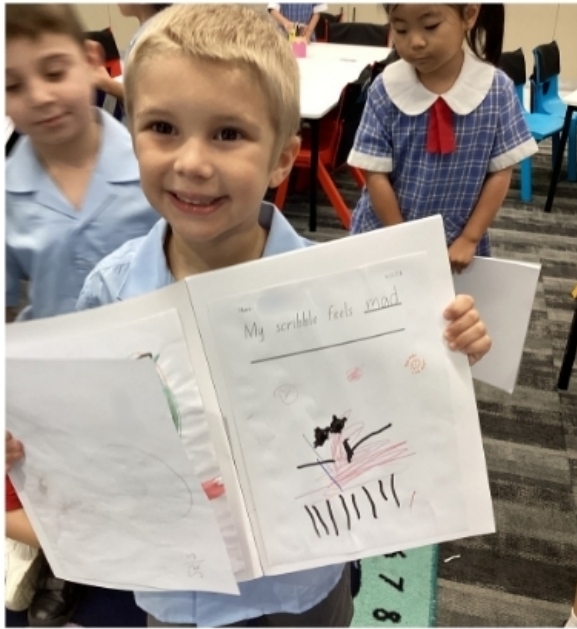
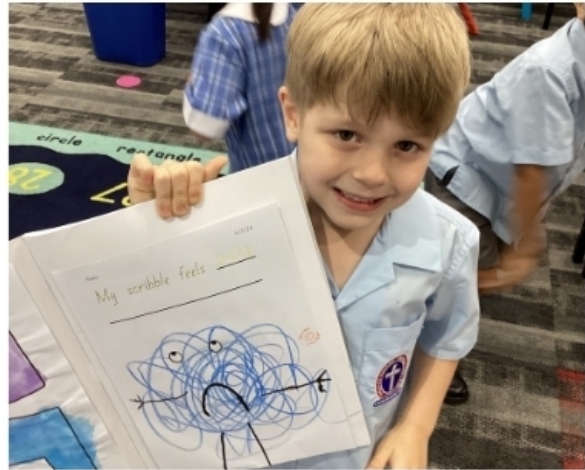
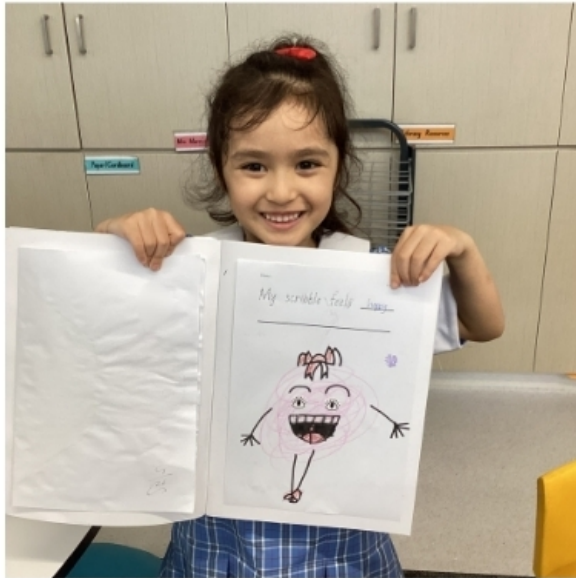
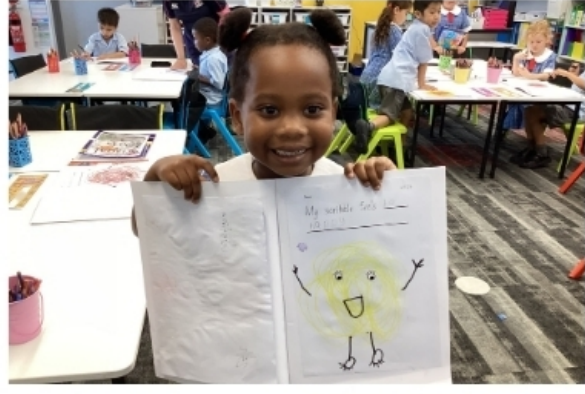




THESE AREN'T JUST SCRIBBLES
