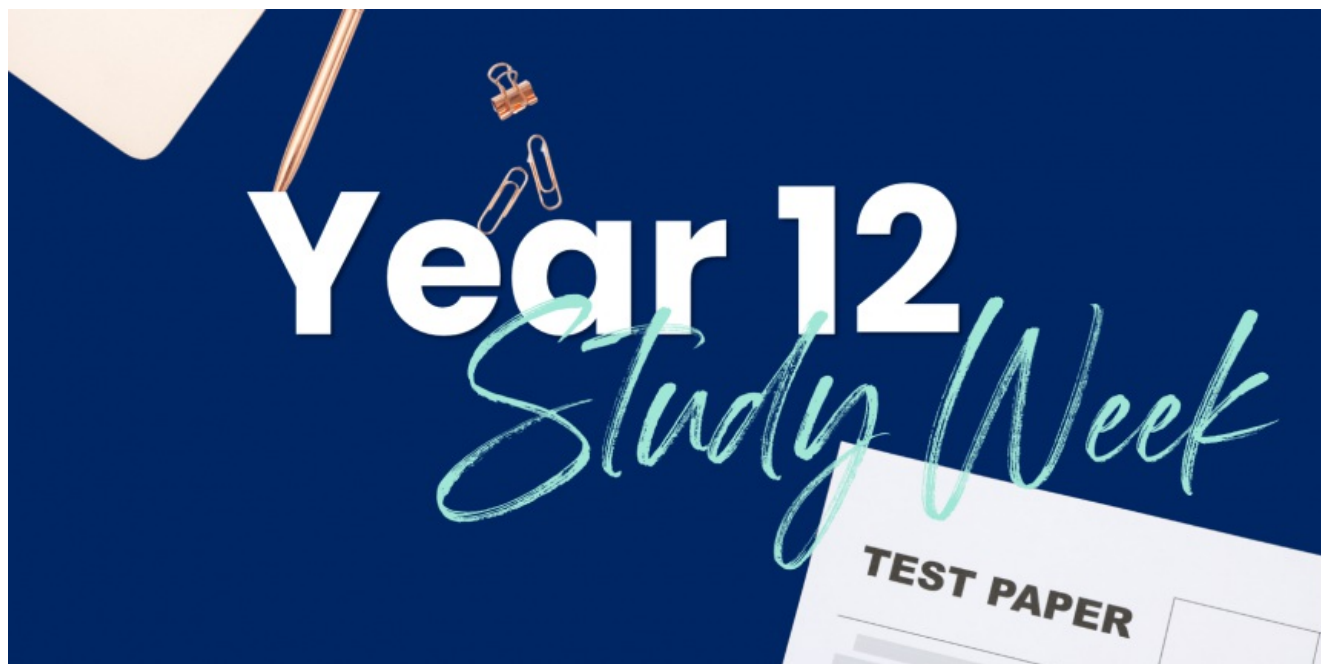

YEAR 12 HSC TRIAL PREPARATION
